



Dear WZ family members,

Greetings from Dr. Kandarp Parikh.

Unprecedented Covid crisis is gradually fading down and now it's conference time across India. We, all the members of WZ are eager to meet during WZUSICON at Nasik, Maharashtra. The enthusiasm is palpable and all set to go in few days from now. We the west zone council have a pleasant duty to conduct election for WZ council members. As you know we have completely moved to E-election so I am sending you relevant information for smooth voting procedure.

Voting for the three posts of Council Members USIWZ council will be open from

01 Sep 2022 to 10 Sep 2022

Please note that only Full members of USI West Zone who have registered for voting and have their name in the final list which was sent for everyone's confirmation earlier will be able to vote.

For voting Election portal can be accessed via www.usiwzelections-2022.in

After entering election portal enter your registered email / mobile number to receive OTP.

If the mobile number / email is correct, OTP will be sent to respective email / mobile number.

Kindly enter OTP received and proceed to see list of candidates

Select candidate / candidates for each position and submit your selection.

Whenever there is more than one member to be elected, it is mandatory that the voter votes for the required number of candidates. That means since there are three council member seats, the voter must cast vote for three seats. They cannot cast just one or two votes. Such a vote would not be accepted by system and will be invalid.

Kindly note, each user can vote only once. For security reasons IP addresses, voters email / mobiles are recorded at anonymous level.

Confirmation of your successful voting will be sent by a text message and an email on your registered mobile number and email address.

The date, time and IP address will be recorded as viewed by you after successful voting.

Regarding the security of the election process

There will be mock trial voting exactly simulating final voting process on 29th and 30th August 2022.

One person alone cannot start the voting process. There will be three passwords shared with president, past president and president elect. Once all three passwords are filled in then voting process will start. Same is the case with ending the voting process

The results of the voting will be available at a defined time accessible to the three key members only on utilising three separate keys by three presidents at the same time

All voters will receive OTP on mobile and e mail for voting for secure voting

Only one vote per person, per membership number, per mobile phone, per single ip address is allowed.
